

TOWN OF FLORENCEVILLE-BRISTOL
A BY-LAW TO REPEAL SEVERAL BY-LAWS OF THE FORMER VILLAGE OF
FLORENCEVILLE AND THE FORMER VILLAGE OF BRISTOL
BY-LAW NO. 99

The Council of the Municipality of Florenceville-Bristol under authority vested in it by Section 20(1) of the *Municipalities Act*, R.S.N.B. 1973, c. M-22 and amendments thereto enacts the following by-law:

1. The following by-laws, enacted by the former Village of Florenceville and former Village of Bristol Council and amendments thereto, are here by repealed:
 - 1.1. By-law No. 1, *A By-law Respecting the Renumeration of the Mayor and Councillors*, of the former Village of Bristol;
 - 1.2. By-law No. 7, *A By-law Respecting to Prevent Nuisances*, of the former Village of Bristol passed on October 15, 1985;
 - 1.3. By-law No. 14, *Emergency Planning By-law*, of the former Village of Bristol passed on June 8, 1992 and By-law No. 35, *Community Emergency Planning By-law*, of the former Village of Florenceville passed on June 16, 1992;
 - 1.4. By-law No. 50, *Sewer By-law*, of the former Village of Bristol passed on September 8, 1986 and By-law No. 30, *A By-law Regulating the Use of the Sewer System*, of the former Village of Florenceville passed on September 3, 1991;
 - 1.5. By-law No. 7, *A By-law Relating to the Licensing and Regulating of Household Pets*, of the former Village of Bristol and passed on February 17, 2003 and By-law No. 2-3, *A By-law Relating to the Licensing and Regulating of Household Pets*, of the former Village of Florenceville passed on January 27, 2003.
2. The repeal of said by-laws shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
