

# Canada's Historic Places in Florenceville-Bristol

The Canadian Register of Historic Places (CRHP) is Canada's definitive source of information on historic places. Here you can not only learn about more than 13,000 historic places, you can also find useful conservation tools, such as the *Standards and Guidelines for the Conservation of Historic Places in Canada* - a benchmark guide for the conservation of historic resources.

Federal, Provincial and Territorial governments recognize the contribution historic places make to our communities. Since 2001, they have worked together to develop the CRHP.

A **historic place** is a structure, building, group of buildings, district, landscape, archaeological site or other place in Canada that has been formally recognized for its heritage value by an appropriate authority within a jurisdiction.
