TOWN OF FLORENCEVILLE-BRISTOL A BYLAW RESPECTING THE COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL AND THE REMUNERATION OF THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCILLORS BY-LAW NO. 2

Be it enacted by the Council of the town of Florenceville-Bristol under the authority vested in it by the *Local Governance Act*, R.S.N.B., 2017, Chapter 18 and amendments thereto replaces the by-law enacted July 8, 2008 with the following by-law:

1. APPLICATION

This by-law sets out the composition of the Council and the remuneration of the Mayor and the councilors.

2. COMPOSITION

- 2.1 The Council consists of:
 - a) One (1) Mayor elected at large, and
 - b) Three (3) Councillors elected from the ward of Florenceville, and
 - c) Three (3) Councillors elected from the ward of Bristol

3. REMUNERATION

- 3.1 The salary of the Mayor is \$11,000.00 per year payable semi-annually in equal installments.
- 3.2 The salary of the Deputy Mayor is \$7,300.00 per year payable semi-annually in equal.
- 3.3 The salary of each Councillor is \$5,500.00 per year payable semi-annually in equal installments.
- 3.4 Included in the salary provided for in subsection (1), the allowance of the Mayor for expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as Mayor is as reasonable debts incurred.
- 3.5 Included in the salary provided for in subsection (2), the allowance of the Deputy Mayor for expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties as Deputy Mayor is as reasonable debts incurred.
- 3.6 Included in the salary provided for in subsection (3), the allowance of each Councillor for expenses incidental to the discharge of his duties as Councillor is as reasonable debts incurred.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

A review of Council salaries shall be completed by Council in the year prior to a municipal election to ensure Council salaries are in line with other communities of similar size and responsibility. Council may approve a salary adjustment that can only take effect at the beginning of the new Council term.
